# Funding is available to:

#### **Individuals**

- Non-Community Based Organisations (Non-CBOs)
- Women's Groups
- Youth Groups
- Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs)
- Non-Profit Organisations (NPOs)
- · People Living with Disabilities

#### 2. WHO CANNOT APPLY

# The following are not eligible for EIF grants:

- Community Based Organisations (CBOs), Conservancies, Community Forests
- Commercial farms and farmers, farmers' associations, cooperatives, water point associations/committees
- Individuals or groups previously supported by EIF
- · EIF staff
- All levels of government and their staff, state-owned enterprises
- Private sector companies (LTDs, PTY Ltd)
- Researchers, research institutions (e.g., Gobabeb, DRFN, MRC, SANUMARC, EEI, NBRI, NCRST)
- Academic institutions (e.g., UNAM, NUST, IUM, LINGUA, NAMCOL)
- Vocational training institutions (e.g., VTC, NTA, NIMT, COSDEC, TVET, DAPP)
- Capacity-building institutes

### 3. WHAT WE FUND - INVESTMENT THEMES

# Projects must fall under one or more of the following themes:

- Sustainable Natural Resource Management & Utilisation
- Sustainable Tourism SMEs
- Nature-based Enterprises & Natural Resource Value Addition
- Green Technologies, Low Carbon Development, Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency
- Sustainable / Climate-Smart Agriculture
- Solid Waste Management & Recycling (including SMEs)

#### 4. GRANT SIZE & DURATION

Grant amounts range from N\$50,000 to N\$150,000. Projects must be completed within 8 months of award.

#### 5. SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS

# We look for projects that:

Replace unsustainable practices with sustainable solutions Offer innovation and potential for replication in other areas Provide opportunities for learning and knowledge sharing Can be sustained beyond the grant period

#### **6. EXPECTED IMPACTS**

**Environmental**: Protect biodiversity, improve air/soil quality, enhance conservation

**Social:** Improve health, safety, education, and preserve cultural heritage

**Economic:** Create jobs, reduce poverty, boost productivity, strengthen energy/water security

**Gender:** Address gender inequalities, particularly in climate change vulnerability

#### 7. HOW TO APPLY

Note: Applications are accepted only during an open call for proposals.

Calls are announced via local newspapers, EIF social media, and the EIF website.
